SAFETY

CLIFFS: Most cliffs are fenced. The higher sea cliffs are fenced with the exception of those near #53. Between Bondi and Tamarama there is no fence, but there is a well defined path. Inside the harbour there are small cliffs on the course, some fenced and some not.

ROADS: No attempt has been made to obtain road closures, please show due care when crossing roads particularly at the start.

PATHS: The stairs between Marathon Road and Marathon Mews (Darling Point) are dangerous and closed - DO NOT USE.

MAP

ACCESS: All markers can be approached from at least two directions. Some paths have been drawn in, however, there are many unmarked paths between streets, and unmarked paths to parks. (see SAFETY - paths).

SYDNEY HARBOUR NATIONAL PARK: Entry was conditional on the course following main tracks. There is no need to leave or make new tracks.

CENTENNIAL PARK: Entry was conditional on providing a first aid and marshal station in the park. This will be located at #71 (along with the watermelons)

OUT OF BOUNDS: Please note the three out of bounds areas on the map (/////////).

PRIVATE PROPERTY: There has been no attempt to obtain access to private property nor is there any reason to enter private property to complete this course.

At #53 the control can be seen from a distance. There is no need to intrude on the privacy of the property owner.

CORRECTIONS: #27 should be located 3mm further north - on the intersection of the cliff line and red control circle - SEE MASTER MAP.
